## Sunday 9 November - Procession and Service.

Time	Activity
10:10am	Band starts procession from Longridge Civic Hall.
10:30am	Procession arrives at St Wilfrid's Church. Wreath laid by the Mayor, band will stay in place. Parade Marshall (PM) invites the Mayor to fall out.
10:45am	Procession arrives at the Memorial Garden, Berry Lane. Parade falls out upon the instruction of the PM
10:53am	Readings by the Vicar and member of the Royal British Legion.
11:00am	The Last Post is sounded by Sion Lloyd Two minutes silence held. <b>Wreaths will be laid.</b>
11:10 - 11:20am	Member of the Royal British Legion announce the procession will make way to Christ Church. PM and band make their way to Christ Church steps and parade stops. Vicar greets procession and Mayor takes wreath into church. Civic Party are instructed to fall out to the left.
11:25am	The procession moves to St. Paul's Church and stops. Fall out is given and procession proceeds into St Paul's for church service. The band usually play one of the Hymns and also a piece during the collection or interval.
12:30pm	Church Service ends.
12:35pm	PM reassembles the band and procession and return to the Civic Hall. The procession will proceed towards Willows Park Lane.
12:45pm	Mayor thanks everyone for attending band plays the National Anthem. Civic Party fall out and the band and parade will be dismissed by the PM
<b>12:50pm</b>	<b>Light refreshments at Longridge Civic Hall.</b>
